

A Guide to Preparing CD Artwork

CD Specification

Unless otherwise specified all our CDs are supplied in Jewel Cases with a 4 page colour booklet and rear inlay tray. If you are creating your own artwork then you can obtain the correct templates from our website under the 'Downloads and Guides' section.

If you would like Recordings 4 Choirs to create your CD artwork then please supply the following information.

Front Cover

Your CD needs a title which will feature on the front cover along with your Choir Name. A lot of our clients will use a recent photograph of the choir for their cover or an image which relates to the title or theme of your album.

Booklet Inside Pages

The booklet which sits in the front of the jewel case has two inside pages which can feature text or photographs. A lot of choirs like to include a list of everyone who has featured on the album along with some photographs of the recording session. You might also wish to include some programme notes on the music if you wished.

Booklet Back Page

This will be visible on the left as you open the CD case. Usually information about the choir and Music team will go here along with a photograph or choir logo if you have one.

CD Surface

This will feature the album name and the name of your choir along with our standard copyright notices.

Rear Inlay

The back of the CD case will give details of the track list and any soloists as appropriate. We also include a standard copyright notice along with details of where and when the album was recorded.

Further information

Ultimately it is your album and you can feature whatever information you wish. The above is simply intended as a guide to help you produce content for your artwork. If you need any help or advice please do not hesitate to contact us.

Please try to supply the information for your CD artwork at the earliest opportunity to avoid any delays in producing your album.
